



## The DPS Kid

Based on student, parent, and staff input we have come up with our DPS Kid, the skills and attributes we would like to see them develop over their 6 years with us. Overwhelmingly what the school community wanted was to develop great citizens, good people, so we have linked your ideas to our PRIDE values, and expanded upon them

This first table is what we will use with the children. The PRIDE word in Te Reo Māori, a whakatauki to help explain the concept, and then some actions that children can do and work on. We have tried to keep this part short and simple, so that the children will be able to 'carry this' in their heads
